
ST JAMES'S PARK

TG-STUDIO LONDON, ENGLAND

The master bathroom of this reimagined 1970s apartment in central London pays homage to the luxurious baths in Bath, Somerset. The L-shape of the room has been separated into two volumes, the main part of the bathroom accommodating the large walk-in shower and toilet, as well as a recess housing the double vanity unit. All walls and floors have been tiled with rare Portland stone which was used in Bath and Regent Streets of London. The recess side walls and ceiling are covered in green back-painted glass which is backlit and creates a sense of comfort and calmness.

Clean lines flow throughout the bathroom, with concealed storage behind the mirrors and fittings from the American supplier Waterworks, providing a timeless luxury. A slab of Grigio Billiemi marble imported from Italy completes the impression of timeless elegance.
